In celebration of Asian American/Pacific Islander Heritage Month, the Middlesex Vicinage will host a program, "Asian American History Is U.S. History," on Tuesday, May 29 from noon to 1:30 p.m. in courtroom 201, second floor of the Middlesex County Courthouse, 56 Paterson St., New Brunswick.

The program will feature guest speaker Khyati Y. Joshi, professor of education at Farleigh Dickinson University.
