## **Gloucester County Juvenile Probation to Host 17<sup>th</sup> Graduation of Cognitive Skills Program**

The juvenile probation division in Gloucester County will hold a ceremony for 10 graduates of its cognitive skills program on Wednesday, June 13 at 5 p.m. in courtroom 203, second floor, Gloucester County Justice Complex, 70 Hunter St., Woodbury.

Superior Court Judge George H. Gangloff will welcome the graduates, Juvenile Probation Supervisor Terry Miles will host the ceremony and Freeholder Jim Jefferson will address the graduates.

The cognitive skills program is a 15-week program facilitated by the Gloucester County Juvenile Probation Unit and Robins' Nest, a community-based organization serving at-risk children. The program collaborates with Camp Edge at Ranch Hope in Alloway Township, Salem County, which offers team and trust building skills.
