## ISP Seeking Volunteers to Serve on Screening Board

The New Jersey Judiciary's Office of Probation Services is seeking volunteers to serve on the Intensive Supervision Program (ISP) Screening Review Board.

ISP provides an opportunity for nonviolent inmates to serve a portion of their prison terms in the community under strict supervision.

Board members review assessment reports of inmates who have applied to ISP and conduct interviews with inmates via videoconferencing or at a state prison. Candidates recommended for acceptance into ISP are referred to the ISP Resentencing Panel, which is comprised of judges appointed by Chief Justice Stuart Rabner.

Volunteers are appointed by the court for a provisional term of one year and could be reappointed for additional three-year terms. They must undergo a screening process that includes completion of an application, an interview, fingerprinting and a criminal background check. Selected volunteers must attend program-specific training and will be asked to sign a confidentiality oath.
