Essex Vicinage to Hold Domestic Violence Summit

The Essex County Domestic Violence Working Group and the Essex County Family Justice Center will hold a domestic violence summit on Friday, Sept. 21 from 8 a.m. to 4 p.m. at Seton Hall Law School, 1109 Raymond Blvd, Newark.

The summit will offer judges, Judiciary staff and stakeholders the opportunity to discuss ways to identify and address domestic violence and the risks it poses to better protect victims and their families.

A keynote presentation will focus on identifying and addressing risk in domestic violence situations and will examine ways to improve results for families. Areas of focus will include risks of domestic violence, such as system intervention and marginalization, children, and strangulation. A final session will allow all participants to share their perspectives and discuss how to integrate lessons learned into their daily work.
