## **Camden Vicinage Seeks Volunteers for Child Placement Review Boards**

The Camden Vicinage is seeking citizen volunteers to serve on child placement review (CPR) boards, announced Assignment Judge Deborah Silverman Katz.

CPR board volunteers monitor the cases of children placed in foster care or residential placements by child protective services to ensure the best interest of the children are being met. Board members review case related documents and interview interested parties to make recommendations to the court.

CPR board members are appointed by the court for a provisional term of one year and could be reappointed for additional three-year terms. Prospective board members must undergo a screening process that includes a volunteer application, interview, fingerprinting and criminal background check. Selected volunteers must attend program-specific training. CPR boards begin at 9:30 a.m. on designated Wednesdays and Thursdays.
