## **Union Vicinage Celebrates Law Day 2019**

The Union Vicinage and the Union County Bar Association will host a variety of Law Day activities at 11:30 a.m. on Friday, May 3 in the courtroom of Assignment Judge Karen M. Cassidy at the Union County Courthouse, 2 Broad St., Elizabeth.

Students from many of the local schools who have submitted posters, essays and video as part of their Law Day learning activities will participate. Vicinage staff and bar association representatives will acknowledge three winners in each category during the program.

The Burnet Middle School All Star Select Chorus will perform.

The 2019 Law Day theme, "Free Speech, Free Press, Free Society," focuses on these cornerstones of representative government and calls on citizens to understand and protect these rights to ensure, as the U.S. Constitution proposes, "the blessings of liberty for ourselves and our posterity."

Established by President Dwight D. Eisenhower in 1958, Law Day was designated as "a day of national dedication to the principles of government under law."
