Middlesex Vicinage to Host Municipal Court Program

The Middlesex Vicinage will host a municipal court program on Wednesday, May 22 from 5:30 to 8 p.m. at the New Brunswick Public Library, 60 Livingston Ave., New Brunswick.

Topics to be addressed include the role of the municipal division, an overview of the municipal court process, an overview of Criminal Justice Reform, the roles of the municipal prosecutor and public defender, and a discussion about a program that addresses mental health issues.

Speakers will include court staff, representatives from the Office of the Public Defender and the Middlesex County Prosecutor's Office and a representative from Rutgers University Behavioral Health Care.
