Middlesex Vicinage Recognizes Law Day 2019

In recognition of Law Day 2019, the Middlesex Vicinage is conducting presentations to students at local high schools in May on the theme “Free Speech, Free Press, Free Society.”

This Law Day theme – focusing on the cornerstones of representative government – explores the prominence that the topics of freedom of speech and the press have in public discourse and litigation.

Superior Court Judge James F. Hyland will address students at Piscataway High School on Thursday, May 23. Students will have the opportunity discuss the history of freedom of speech and of the press, as well as explore how the evolution of technology has changed this pair of freedoms.
