## **Burlington Vicinage to Conduct Virtual Court Election Day Hearings**

Superior Court judges will be available in the Burlington Vicinage to conduct remote hearings for any election challenges or issues in Burlington County on Tuesday, July 7.

This year's primary election was moved from June 2 because of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Tuesday's election will be vote-by-mail as instructed at:

Anyone seeking to petition the court on a voting or election issue on the date of the election can contact the Burlington County Superior Court at 609-288-9500, ext. 38803. If appropriate, the matter will be heard promptly by a designated judge with notice to the election officials. Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys will be able to appear before the designated judge by video or telephone.
