Mercer Vicinage to Conduct Virtual Election Day Hearings

Superior Court judges in the Mercer Vicinage will be available to conduct remote hearings for election challenges or issues on Tuesday, July 7.

This year's primary election, which was moved from June 2 because of the COVID-19 pandemic, has been designated as a "primarily vote by mail" election. However, judges will be available until all polling locations close for the evening on July 7.

Court staff will coordinate the virtual proceedings. Appearances by petitioners, election officials and attorneys will take place by video or telephone.

As announced by the Mercer County clerk, voters can obtain applications and ballots in person at the Mercer County Clerk's Office, 209 S. Broad St., Trenton until July 7 during business hours.
