## **Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage to Conduct Virtual Court Election Day Hearings**

Superior Court judges will be available in the Cumberland/Gloucester/Salem Vicinage to conduct remote hearings for election challenges or issues in all three counties on Tuesday, July 7. This year's primary election was moved from June 2 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Tuesday's election will be vote-by-mail or in-person vote. The county clerk's office has mailed ballots to registered voters.

If appropriate, matters will be heard promptly by a designated judge with notice to election officials. Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys will be able to appear before the designated judge by video or telephone. Voters with election-related issues or questions about the July 7 election or who are seeking assistance with casting their vote can contact the county clerk's office and/or the board of elections.
