## Bergen Vicinage to Conduct Virtual Court Election Day Hearings

Superior Court judges will be available to conduct remote hearings for election challenges or issues in Bergen County on Tuesday, July 7, Assignment Judge Bonnie J. Mizdol and Trial Court Administrator Laura A. Simoldoni announced today.

This year's primary election was moved from June 2 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Tuesday's election will be vote-by-mail. Those who choose not to use the mail-in ballot and want to vote in person at one of Bergen's designated polling places on Tuesday will only be able to cast a vote using a provisional paper ballot. Voting machines will be available for voters with disabilities who need the accessible voting device.
