Hudson Vicinage to Conduct Virtual Court Election Day Hearings

Superior Court judges will be available in Hudson County to conduct remote hearings for election challenges or issues on Tuesday, July 7.

This year's primary election was moved from June 2 because of the COVID-19 pandemic. Tuesday's election will be vote-by-mail or in-person vote. The county clerk's office has mailed ballots to registered voters. Provisional voting will be available at a limited number of polling locations, which will be open for ADA accommodations and for voters who did not receive their official mail-in ballot.

If appropriate, matters will be heard promptly by a designated judge with notice to election officials. Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys will be able to appear before the designated judge by video or telephone.

Voters with election-related concerns or questions about the July 7 election or who are seeking assistance with casting their vote can contact the county clerk's office and/or the board of elections.
