Morris/Sussex Vicinage Drug Courts to Hold Graduation Ceremonies

The Morris/Sussex Vicinage will hold graduation ceremonies virtually for participants of the drug court program in Sussex County on Thursday, Oct. 8 and Thursday, Oct. 22 at 9:30 a.m.

Superior Court Judge Michael E. Hubner will host the ceremonies.

The Judiciary's drug court program operates within the Superior Court to address nonviolent, drug addicted offenders. The program requires completion of four phases of intensive drug and alcohol treatment and recovery. This level of supervision permits the program to support the recovery process but also allows supervisors to react quickly to impose appropriate therapeutic sanctions or to reinstate criminal proceedings when participants do not comply.

The drug court program in Sussex County has 125 participants.
