Monmouth and Ocean Vicinages to Hold Virtual Expungement Informational Webinar

Monmouth and Ocean vicinages will hold a virtual expungement informational webinar on Tuesday, April 13 from 10-11 a.m. via Zoom. Vicinage staff and representatives from South Jersey Legal Services will discuss how self-represented litigants can file a petition for expungement on the New Jersey Judiciary eCourts expungement system.

The webinar will provide an overview of the expungement process, information on new laws, and an explanation of procedures for filing a petition for expungement. Other topics include a review of the application form, how to complete the petition online and what happens after an expungement has been granted. Expungement forms are available at njcourts.gov.
