## **Camden Vicinage to Conduct Virtual and In-Person Court Election Hearings**

Superior Court judges will be available in Camden County to conduct remote or in-person hearings for primary election-related issues on Tuesday, June 8.

Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys will be able to appear before the court by video, telephone or in person at the courthouses.

Voters with primary election-related concerns or questions about the June 8 primary or who are seeking assistance on how to cast their vote can contact the county clerk's office and/or board of elections. If appropriate, these offices will make arrangements for the voter to appear remotely or report to a designated courtroom at the courthouse, where a hearing will be conducted.
