Monmouth Vicinage to Conduct Virtual and In-Person Election Day Hearings

Superior Court judges will be available to conduct remote or in-person hearings for primary election challenges or issues in Monmouth County on Tuesday, June 8 from 6 a.m. to 8 p.m., Assignment Judge Lisa P. Thornton and Trial Court Administrator Gurpreet M. Singh announced today.

Anyone seeking to petition the court on a voting or election issue on the date of the primary can contact the Superior Court at 732-358-8700, ext. 87590, or at MONEmergent.Mailbox@njcourts.gov.

If appropriate, the matter will be promptly heard by a designated judge with notice to election officials. Election officials, petitioners, and attorneys can appear before the designated judge by video, telephone or in person. Individuals who do not have access to a telephone to participate in a virtual proceeding can appear at the Monmouth County Board of Elections, 300 Halls Mills Road, Freehold, where arrangements will be made for a remote or in-person hearing.
