## **Monmouth Vicinage to Hold Constitution Day Outreach**

In recognition of Constitution Day and as part of ongoing outreach efforts, staff representatives from the Monmouth Vicinage will conduct informational outreach in the community, including the farmer's market in downtown Freehold, on Friday, Sept. 16.

Court staff will be available outside the Hall of Records, 1 E. Main St., Freehold Borough, from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. during the farmer's market. In addition to providing materials to the public, court employees also will provide information about the court's functions and services, as well as employment and volunteer opportunities.

Constitution Day, also known as Citizenship Day, marks the day 39 delegates to the Constitutional Convention signed the U.S. Constitution on Sept. 17, 1787.
