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## Morris/Sussex Vicinage to Hold Virtual Employer and Resource Fair

The Morris/Sussex Vicinage will hold a virtual employer and resource fair for probation clients and recovery court participants on Monday, Oct. 24 at 10 a.m.

As part of the Judiciary's JOBS (Judiciary Opportunities for Building Success) Program, the Judiciary has partnered with local employers and social services agencies to help prepare clients and participants with job readiness skills and to connect with employers.

Presentations and question-and-answer sessions will be provided from the New Jersey Department of Labor, Morris County Community College, U.S. Army, U.S. Navy, the Sussex Transportation Authority, as well social services offices in Morris and Sussex counties. The resources could include educational benefits, grant funding for professional development, housing and rental assistance, and food stability.
