With respect to the pending motion submitted by the New Jersey NAACP State Conference, New Jersey State AFL-CIO, and the New Jersey Building and Construction Trades Council captioned as a "Motion to Intervene as Amici Curiae," and the motion by the Association of Criminal Defense Lawyers of New Jersey for leave to participate as amicus curiae, the State takes no position as to whether the applicants may appear as amici curiae and file their briefs for the Court's consideration.
